



MALE INTIMATE WAXING (BRAZILIAN WAXING)

Male intimate waxing (also known as Brazilian or Boyzilian waxing and the 'back, sac and crack') is the latest trend in men's grooming, with customers often travelling many miles to find a therapist willing and able to provide a first class service.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: What is non-strip wax? What's so great about this new generation of waxes?

A: You may have heard it referred to as hard wax, peelable wax, film wax or hot wax. Traditional hot wax is applied in a thick layer or built up over several layers, usually in a fiddly figure-of-eight pattern to ensure a thorough coating of all hairs. It is left to cool and harden on the skin and is then removed by hand, taking the hair with it. The latest generation of non-strip waxes share the unique 'shrink wrapping' abilities of older hot waxes but are lower in temperature, easier to apply and stay flexible as they cool. This makes them much more comfortable for the client and an ideal choice for removing short, coarse and stubborn hairs anywhere on the body.

Q: I've never used Perron Rigot non-strip wax before, is that a problem?

A: Our workshops are open to all qualified hair removal technicians, regardless of the brand you currently use or your preferred technique (strip wax, hot wax or sugaring). An introduction to Perron Rigot waxes and accessories will be provided on the day, and there will be plenty of time to practice your skills during the remainder of the workshop. For those that enjoy using the Perron Rigot range, there will be an opportunity to purchase waxes and discounted starter kits from Thalgo, the UK distributor. We also offer specialist training for therapists new to non-strip waxing who want to offer their clients the very latest in advanced depilatory techniques; please contact us for details.

Q: Do I need to supply anything on the day?

A: **In-house training** - Perron Rigot non-strip wax and depilatory oil will be provided by the tutor for training purposes. You are responsible for ensuring adequate provision of all other waxing equipment and supplies. You will also need to provide your own models: one demonstration model to be waxed by the tutor in the morning, plus at least one practice model for every two delegates in attendance in the afternoon.

One-to-one training - all waxing equipment and supplies are provided free of charge at our private Basingstoke classes. You may bring your own models, or we can supply them for a daily fee.

Group workshops - all waxing equipment, supplies and models are provided on the day.

Q: Can you help with finding models?

A: You are responsible for providing your own models for any in-house training, but we do have a database of UK volunteers and may be able to help with recruiting clients if given enough notice. Models are provided free of charge at our group workshops in London and Hinckley.

Q: Does this class cover female Brazilian waxing?

A: No, we offer separate training in female intimate waxing; please contact us for more information.

Q: Is this course suitable for beginners?

A: Our Brazilian waxing workshop is only open to therapists already in possession of a basic waxing qualification. Due to the specialised nature of intimate hair removal, this class is designed for experienced therapists and you must be competent in the 'pot and spatula' method of waxing before attending.
